

Second Grade Unit 1: Furniture

2nd Grade is studying items typically found in a bedroom. One way to help them study would be to have your child draw a picture of their bedroom and then label the items in the drawing. Another option would be to make signs with the Spanish words and attach them to the items in their bedroom so they will become familiar with the way the words look. If you want to challenge your child have them talk about the items in their room by combining the new vocabulary with color words. Just remember that adjectives come after nouns in Spanish so a “blue bed” would be a *cama azul*.
