El amigo = {el. a.ME.go} the friend (who is a boy)

La amiga = {la. a.ME.ga} the friend (who is a girl)

Simpático = {seem.PA.tee.co} nice, friendly (boy)

Simpática = {seem.PA.tee.ca} nice, friendly (girl)

Estudioso = {es.to.dee.O.so} studious (boy)

Estudiosa = {es.to.dee.O.sa} studious (girl)

él = {L}he

Ella = {eh.ya} she

No = no, not

No es = is not

Es = is

Review words:

Mi = my

Mis = my (plural)

Tu = your

Tus = your (plural)

Alto = tall (boy)

Alta = tall (girl)

Bajo = short (boy)

Baja = short (girl)
