- Welcome and Introductions
- Important guidelines that must be followed:
 1. Temperatures will be taken before boarding the bus or before entering the building (non bus riders). If a student has a temperature they will not be allowed to board the bus. If your child is not feeling well, please keep them home.
 2. Students will remain in one classroom for the entire day. Movement breaks and fresh air breaks will be provided. Breakfast and lunch will be served in the classroom.
 3. Water fountains are closed, please send water with your child.
 4. Masks **must** be worn at all times (except for eating and drinking).
 5. Students will not be allowed to gather on campus. Students must practice social distancing of 6 feet.
 6. Students will not be allowed to leave for lunch (we are a closed campus).
 7. Students will not be allowed to use lockers - must keep all belongings with them.
 8. Visitors will not be allowed in the buildings.
 9. Student drivers will dismiss at 3:50 and bus riders will dismiss at 4:00.
 10. Any student driving to the high school must have a parking pass in the vehicle as well as a registration form on file.
 11. Any student who becomes ill during the day with Covid like symptoms will be placed in an isolation room while waiting for a parent/guardian to pick them up. The student will either need to take a Covid test and provide a negative result or remain at home for 10 days. They can participate virtually during this time.
 12. Custodians will fog rooms and buildings daily as well as cleaning surface areas throughout the day.
 13. All buses will be cleaned after the morning and afternoon route. Students will have assigned seats on the bus with no more than two to a seat at all times. Masks must be worn on the bus.
 14. The district will have an inspection done by the County Fire Marshall and the Springer Fire Chief to ensure that all PED requirements are met.
 15. Student desks will be placed 6 feet apart and the same student will sit in the same desk daily.
- Students are not to be on cell phones during instructional time.
- Expectations for joining class remotely
 1. No background noise and full participation is expected. Teachers will have office hours to work with virtual students in small group settings or one on one.
