2012-2013 SCHOOL YEAR BUS APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

School Committee Transportation Policy

The Walpole Public School Department shall provide town paid transportation to students in grades K-6 who live in excess of 2 miles from their assigned school. All other students in grades K-12 have the option to purchase a bus pass through the Fee Based Busing Program and will be accepted on a space available basis. This policy will also affect students who attend non-public schools and are transported to school via Walpole Public Schoolsqbuses.

General Instructions

- All students need to be registered annually if bus service is desired.
- Complete one application per household listing the names of all students in the household who will be riding the bus.
- If you wish to pay the bus fee online by MasterCard, American Express, Discover or electronic funds transfer from your checking account, please visit the Business Office/Online Payment website at www.walpole.k12.ma.us. If the bus fee is paid online, you will not need to file a paper application.
- For a street listing for students in grades K-6 who live 2 miles and beyond from the school they are attending and are eligible for free transportation, please refer to the Business Office website.
- All bus applications that are not free that are received without the proper payment amount will be returned to you unprocessed. A student will not be issued a bus pass unless all fees or charges are paid or waived.
- Prior to the start of school, bus routes will be published in the Walpole Times for specific pick up and drop off locations.
- Bus passes will be issued at each school during the first week of classes. Students are required to carry a bus pass starting Monday, September 17, 2012.
- Bus service will include pickup and drop off at the same location each day (for grades 1-12) with exceptions being made when road, safety and weather conditions dictate differently. Mid-day kindergarten drop off points will be at the home where allowed by policy.
- The school district does not prorate the fee for one way transportation or for less than full use.

Wait List Instructions

- Bus applications received after August 17, 2012 will be placed on a **wait list** in the order they are received.
- Any available seats will be assigned on a %irst received, first served+basis by September 14, 2012, approximately one week after school begins.

Requests for Fee Waivers

- Submit your confidential request in writing to the School Business Office at the same time you submit the bus application. Include in your request a copy of the family most recent federal income tax return or other state or federal documentation that denotes family size and income.
- Decisions are based on the Federal Governments Guidelines for the Free and Reduced Lunch program offered in Walpole Public Schools and a review of the material presented.
- Approvals are not guaranteed.
