Special Start	<p>Assignments for English/Language Arts and Mathematics based on IEP goals and objectives. <i>(For example: Math Conversations: Use regular household items like Cheerios, popsicle sticks, Legos, etc., to talk about numbers (1 through 5) with your child: count them, group similar objects together, sort different items.
