



Let's Talk Enrollment...

Dear Families, the Community Art Center is cautiously beginning to phase in our reopening plans. With that in mind, we want to emphasize that above all else, we are considering the health and safety of our community members as top priority. We need to ensure that our children, their families, our staff, and their families, all remain safe. And this will take everyone's commitment to help.

Things will look a bit different at the Community Art Center for the foreseeable future. At least until COVID-19 is under control.

- We will be at a reduced capacity, to maintain necessary spacing
- Our teen programs will function, mostly remotely
- Priority accommodations will be given to existing families, and those most in need of essential child-care and we will be taking extra precautions to make sure that everyone stays safe & healthy

Some of the safety measures will include:

- Improved filtration and airflow to our HVAC units
- Increased attention to daily cleaning, and disinfecting (with special attention to high touch points)
- MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED FOR EVERYONE AT ALL TIMES
- Students will be expected to maintain social-distancing guidelines established by their teachers
- Temperature checks and a brief questionnaire will be required daily upon entry
- We will be limiting access to the center, to only those participants of programs
- Parents and guardians will have a designated drop-off/pick-up location and time
- Any child who becomes sick or develops a temperature, will be isolated from other children, and their parent/guardian will immediately be called to pick them up
