

Return to School Process

As you are aware, Arlington Public Schools has implemented new processes and procedures during this outbreak of COVID-19 and we are committed to keeping students and staff safety our top priority.

Symptoms of COVID-19:

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

If an individual experiences any 1 or more new, unexplained symptoms, they are to immediately leave campus and follow the Return to School/Work Guidance by the WA State Department of Health.

Class A Symptoms	Class B Symptoms
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Fever (defined as 100.4°F or higher) ● Cough ● Loss of sense of taste and/or smell ● Shortness of breath 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Fatigue ● Headache ● Muscle or body aches ● Sore throat ● Congestion or runny nose ● Nausea or vomiting ● Diarrhea (defined as 2 or more loose stool in 24 hours)

Get Tested:
Known COVID-19 exposure in prior 14 days
OR
Any Class A Symptoms
OR
2 or more Class B Symptoms
OR
1 Class B Symptoms for more than 24 hours

RETURN TO SCHOOL:

- **Positive Results or No COVID test done:**
 - Isolate until at least:
 - 10 days since symptoms
AND
 - 24 hours after fever resolves without use of fever-reducing medications
AND
 - Symptoms have improved
- **Doctor Diagnoses with non COVID illness or Negative results**
 - Isolate until at least:
 - 24 hours after fever resolves without use of fever-reducing medication
AND
 - Symptoms have improved
AND
 - Per condition diagnosed by HCP
Whichever is LONGER
- **Illness with 1 Class B Symptom RESOLVES in less than 24 hours**
 - May return after initial 24 hours
